


## **YIT Descriptive Data: Who Are We Serving?**

Intake sample includes 17 young adults from Middlebury.<sup>+</sup>






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## Youth in Transition Grant (YIT) Outcome Indicators (4/1/10 to 6/30/12)

These findings come from young adults who completed *Common Study* interviews (except for Employment which are from *Vermont & National Studies*) when they started to receive YIT services in their communities (YIT Start). Fewer than 10 *Common Study* interviews were conducted at the 6-month follow-up, so no progress data is available. Sample sizes change because not all questions were answered, and samples <10 not reported for confidentiality.
